SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

The Agency has determined that this will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rule. A SERC has not been prepared by the Agency.

The Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Hotels and Restaurants hereby gives notice:

On May 7, 2015, the Division of Hotels and Restaurants received a Petition for an Emergency Variance for paragraph 61C-1.004(1)(a), F.A.C., and Paragraph 5-202.11(A), 2009 FDA Food Code from EA Tiburon Cafe located in Maitland. The above referenced F.A.C. addresses the requirement that each establishment have an approved plumbing system installed to transport potable water and wastewater. They are requesting to utilize holding tanks to provide potable water and to collect wastewater at the handwash sink in the new preparation area.

The Petition for this variance was published in Vol. 41, No. 92 of the May 12, 2015, F.A.R.. The Order for this Petition was signed and approved on May 19, 2015. After a complete review of the variance request, the Division finds that the application of this Rule will create a financial hardship to the food service establishment.
