6A-3.0141 Employment of School Bus Operators

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose of this rule development is to require school bus operators within the state to meet the medical examination requirements of federally regulated commercial drivers specified in Form 649-F (6045), Medical Examination Report for Commercial Driver Fitness Determination, instead of the Florida School Bus Operators Medical Examination Report for Commercial Driver Fitness Determination (Form ESE 479). Since 1985, the medical examination requirements for school bus operators within the state have been substantially the same as those established by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration for federally regulated commercial drivers. The effect would require Florida school bus operators to continue to adhere to the same medical examination requirements as federally regulated commercial drivers with one exception. Authority to waive federal requirements that allow the medical examiner to specify bus operators with Skill Performance Evaluation Certificates/limb waiver and/or Diabetes and Vision exemptions meet 49 CFR 391.41, medical examination requirements, will not be granted.

(9) Camping. To qualify for a business logo in the camping category, an existing business shall hold a permit under the provisions of Section 513.02 Chapter 513, F.S., and must be located within fifteen miles of the interchange.

Subsections (a) and (b) of Rule 14-85.022(2) are amended to read:

(2) Permit Fees.

(a) ~~The following charts show the groupings for both AADT and population.~~ Annual fees for participation in the Logo Sign Program are computed based upon the Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) at each interchange, the population of the area surrounding the interchange, market conditions, and the costs of the program. The following charts show the groupings for both AADT and population:

The following chart shows the weighted values assigned to each factor:

The fee for each interchange is computed as follows:

(AADT Group x AADT Factor) + (Population Group x Population Factor) + Cost Factor

Under no circumstances shall calculated fee exceed \$3500.00 for an interchange in an urban area, or \$2,000.00 ~~\$2500.00~~ for an interchange outside an urban area.

EXAMPLE: For an interchange with an AADT of 60,000 and a population of 75,000, the fee is computed as follows:

$$\begin{aligned} \text{AADT Group} &= 1 \\ \text{Population Group} &= 2 \\ (1 \times 230) + (2 \times 400) + 1000 &= \$2,030 \end{aligned}$$

The fees calculated above are for a mainline logo sign and ramp logo signs in both directions of the limited access facility interstate. At interchanges where the configuration only allows access to the business in a single direction, one mainline logo sign and one ramp logo sign will be provided and the fee will be one-half (1/2) that computed for both directions.

(b) An annual permit fee of \$1,300.00 is established for all interchanges located within the boundaries of rural communities designated as within a rural area of opportunity RACEC as defined by Section 288.0656(2)(d) and (e), F.S. The list of rural communities and areas designated as rural area of opportunity RACEC is published by the Department of Economic Opportunity Governor's Office of Tourism, Trade and Economic Development. The rural area of opportunity RACEC status will be that which is in effect at the time the invoice for either the initial or renewal billing for participation in the Logo Sign Program is generated. If a rural area of opportunity RACEC designation is secured subsequent to the generation of the invoice, no refund, credit, or pro rata distribution of funds received by the Department for that year will be made to the permittee.

The Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Hotels and Restaurants hereby gives notice:

On March 25, 2015, the Division of Hotels and Restaurants received a Petition for a Routine Variance for Paragraph 4-301.12(A), 2009 FDA Food Code, subsection 61C-4.010(5), F.A.C., Subparagraph 3-305.11(A)(2), 2009 FDA Food Code, and subsection 61C-4.010(1), F.A.C., from Wagonwheel Flea Market Snack Bar #3 located in Pinellas Park. The above referenced F.A.C. addresses the requirement that dishwashing facilities for manually washing, rinsing and sanitizing equipment and utensils are provided for each establishment, and that each establishment have areas for food preparation and storage. They are requesting to share the dishwashing, food preparation and food storage areas with another licensed food service establishment under the same ownership and on the same premises.

After a complete review of the variance request, the Division finds that the application of this Rule will create a financial hardship to the food service establishment. Furthermore, the Division finds that the Petitioner meets the burden of demonstrating that the underlying statute has been achieved by the Petitioner ensuring that the dishwashing, food preparation and food storage areas within Wagon Wheel Snack Bar (NOS6201059) must be maintained in a clean and sanitary manner. These areas must also be available to Wagonwheel Flea Market Snack Bar #3 during all hours of operation. If the ownership of Wagon Wheel Snack Bar and Wagonwheel Flea Market Snack Bar #3 (David Huntly) changes, a signed agreement between the two establishments for the use of the shared facilities must be provided to the division immediately.

The above referenced F.A.C. addresses the requirement for proper handling and dispensing of food. They are requesting to dispense bulk time/temperature control for safety foods from an open air mobile food dispensing vehicle. After a complete review of the variance request, the Division finds that the application of this Rule will create a financial hardship to the food service establishment. Furthermore, the Division finds that the Petitioner meets the burden of demonstrating that the underlying statute has been achieved by the Petitioner ensuring that each pan within the steam table is properly covered with an individual lid; the steam table is enclosed within a cabinet with tight-fitting doors, and is protected by an air curtain installed and operated according to the manufacturer's specifications that protects against flying vermin or other environmental contaminants; all steam table foods must be properly reheated for hot holding at approved commissaries and held hot at the proper minimum temperature per the parameters of the currently adopted FDA Food Code; and steam table food is to be dispensed by the operator with no customer self-service. The Petitioner shall also strictly adhere to the operating procedures and copies of the variance and operating procedures are to be present on the MFDV during all periods of operation.
