The effect of adopting this rule is that procedures that support applications for and the processing of taxpayers’ “portability” requests will be available to taxpayers and property appraisers. SUBJECT AREA TO BE ADDRESSED: The proposed new rule addresses the procedures home owners can use to transfer their assessment limitation difference when they abandon a homestead in one location in Florida and qualify for homestead in another location in Florida.
