62-621.250 General Conditions

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The Department is revising Rule 62-621.250, F.A.C., to implement new federal regulations that require the electronic reporting of information to the Environmental Protection Agency’s (EPA) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) data system. The requirements of the EPA’s E-reporting Rule, including waiver provisions, have previously been adopted by reference in paragraphs 62-620.100(3)(bb) and (cc), F.A.C.

SUMMARY: Proposed paragraph 62-621.250(5)(a), F.A.C., would require the electronic submittal of Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) by permittees covered by the Generic Permit for Discharges from Petroleum Contaminated Sites (subsection 62-621.300(1), F.A.C.). Proposed paragraph 62-621.250(5)(b), F.A.C., would require the electronic submittal of Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) by permittees covered by the Multi-Sector Generic Permit for Stormwater Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity (subsection 62-621.300(5), F.A.C.). The DMR monitoring data would be submitted electronically via the Department’s online business portal.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

The Agency has determined that this will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rule. A SERC has not been prepared by the Agency.

The Agency has determined that the proposed rule is not expected to require legislative ratification based on the statement of estimated regulatory costs or if no SERC is required, the information expressly relied upon and described herein: The requirements of the E-reporting Rule, including waiver provisions, have previously been adopted by reference in paragraphs 62-620.100(3)(bb) and (cc), F.A.C. The E-reporting Rule was adopted pursuant to the federal fast process provided for under section 403.8055, F.S. The electronic

submittal of Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) monitoring data via the Department’s online business portal would reduce costs to permittees by providing a faster, simpler and more efficient process for the submittal of DMRs. A waiver process is available for permittees that choose to continue to submit hard-copies of DMRs.

In addition, Certificates of Authorization must be renewed every two (2) years, and each business organization issued a Certificate of Authorization must notify the Board of any change in the name of the business organization or the business organization’s qualifying Professional Engineer within thirty (30) days of such change.

(2) Applications for an initial Certificate of Authorization or notification of the change of name of the business organization or of the qualifying Professional Engineer, shall be made on Form FBPE/030, 04/17, Application for Certificate of Authorization, which is incorporated by reference herein and may be obtained from <https://fbpe.org/licensure/application-process/certificate-of-authorization/> or at <https://www.flrules.org/Gateway/reference.asp?No=Ref->. All applications must be accompanied by the fee as specified in Rule 61G15-24.001, F.A.C.
