Due to Personal and family reasons related to the birth of his child, Petitioner did not seek employment as a law enforcement officer until June of 2017, when he applied for a position with the City of Opa-Locka Police Department. Petitioner was still undergoing a background check with the Opa-Locka Police Department

when his timeframe for employment expired on July 15, 2017. The Petitioner alleges that, should the waiver not be granted, Petitioner will suffer a substantial hardship as he would be unable to serve as a certified law enforcement officer until he completes another basic recruit training academy and passes another State Officer Certification Examination at his own expense. 62-312.410 General Criteria

The Department of Environmental Protection hereby gives notice of its intent to issue a Consent Order and Variance (1) to resolve all matters with Florida Keys Homes LLC, Andrew George, JC Construction and Sewer, Inc., and Pavel Bacallao (Respondents), pursuant to Section 120.57(4), Florida Statutes (F.S.), for violations of Sections 373.430, and 403.161, F.S., and Rule 62-330.020, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.); and (2) to grant a variance, pursuant to Section 403.201, F.S., to Florida Keys Homes LLC from the provision of subsection 62-312.410(2), F.A.C. The Order addresses the unauthorized placement of approximately 946 square feet of fill on privately-owned submerged bay bottom and construction of a riprap revetment on the property owned by Florida Keys Homes LLC, located at 1792 109th Street Gulf, Marathon, Florida (Monroe County Property Appraiser Parcel ID 00334930-000000), without obtaining a valid permit from the Department. The purpose of the fill placement is to reestablish the historical shoreline of the property and stabilize it with a riprap revetment. The Order sets out penalties for the unauthorized actions and requires certain restorative actions be conducted on the property, including the removal of approximately 472 square feet of fill. The Order also grants a variance under Section 403.201, F.S., from the prohibition to grant an Environmental Resource Permit under subsection 62-312.410(2), F.A.C., and grants regulatory authorization for the permanent placement of approximately 474 square feet of fill on the property subject to the findings and conditions set out in the Order.

The Department will issue the proposed Consent Order and Variance unless a timely petition for administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., before the deadline for filing a petition. On the filing of a timely and sufficient petition, this action will not be final and effective until further order of the Department. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, this process may result in a modification of the proposed agency action or even denial of the application. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are as follows.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's action may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the following information required by Rules 28-106.201 and 28-106.301, F.A.C.:

- (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;
- (b) The name, address, any email address, any facsimile number, and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address, email address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding;
- (c) An explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests are or will be affected by the agency determination;
- (d) A statement of when and how the petitioner received notice of the agency decision;
- (e) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact; or, if there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- (f) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action;
- (g) A statement of the specific rules or statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action, including an explanation of how any alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and;
- (h) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

Petitions must be filed (received by the Clerk) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. The failure of any person to file a petition for an administrative hearing within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. If petitioner is someone other than the Respondents to the Consent Order and Variance, the petitioner shall also mail a copy of the petition to the Respondents at the following addresses: Florida Keys Homes LLC and Andrew George, 6677 Overseas Highway, Marathon, FL 33050; and JC Construction

In accordance with subsection 62-110.106(3), F.A.C., petitions for an administrative hearing by the Respondents to the Consent Order and Variance and persons who have asked the Department in writing to receive notice of this action pursuant to Sections 403.201 and 120.63, F.S., must be filed within 21 days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by any persons other than the applicant and those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within 21 days of publication of the notice or within 21 days of receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first. The failure to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

Under Sections 120.569(2)(c) and (d), F.S., a petition for administrative hearing must be dismissed by the agency if the petition does not substantially comply with the above requirements or is untimely filed.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

On July 13, 2017, the Florida Land and Water Adjudicatory Commission (“FLWAC” or “Commission”) received a petition to amend the boundaries of the Town Center at Palm Coast Community Development District (“Town Center at Palm Coast CDD” or “the District”). The Commission will follow the requirements of Chapter 42-1, F.A.C., and Chapter 190, F.S., as amended, in considering the petition.

SUMMARY OF CONTENTS OF PETITION: The petition requests expansion of the Town Center at Palm Coast CDD by adding approximately 53.62 acres of property adjacent to the District. The Town Center at Palm Coast CDD currently consists of approximately 1,600 acres of land located within the City of Palm Coast, Flagler County, Florida. After expansion, the District will encompass a total of approximately 1,653.62 acres.

SUMMARY OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS: A statement of estimated regulatory costs (SERC) was prepared at the request of the District. Generally, the SERC indicates that the expansion of the District by rule amendment: Is not expected to have any direct or indirect impact on economic growth, private sector job creation or employment, or private sector investment in excess of \$1 million in the aggregate within 5 years after the implementation of the rule; Is not likely to have an adverse impact on business competitiveness;

Is not likely to increase regulatory costs, and will only result in a one-time increase in transactional costs. The entire cost is estimated to be at approximately \$30,000 and will be borne by the District;
