Estimated Capacity

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the State Board of Administration of Florida (the "Board") of the estimated borrowing capacity, estimated claims-paying capacity, and projected balance of the Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund (the "Fund") as of December 31, 2024, in compliance with the requirements of Section 215.555(4)(c)2., Florida Statutes. These estimates relate to the 2024-2025 Reimbursement Contract Year. The projected year-end fund balance available for reimbursement of participating insurers on December 31, 2024, is estimated to be \$7.12 billion, which represents the amount of assets available to pay claims resulting from Covered Events which may occur during the June 1, 2024 through May

31, 2025 Contract Year, not including any bond proceeds. The projected year-end fund balance of \$7.12 billion is net of losses paid and loss reserves from Hurricanes Ian (2022) and Idalia (2023) which the FHCF's independent actuary has estimated to be \$9.501 billion. The 2024-2025 Contract Year claims-paying estimate includes the use of \$7.12 billion of projected year-end fund balance, \$3.25 billion of 2020A and 2024A pre-event bond proceeds and \$7.90 billion of 0-12 month borrowing capacity for a total of \$18.27 billion, which exceeds the \$17 billion limit on the Fund's single-season obligation as specified in Section 215.555, Florida Statutes. The borrowing capacity estimate is dependent on constraints of the financial markets to absorb potential debt issuances, the time necessary to access such markets, and the existing level of interest rates at the time of issuance. The estimates above do not take into account any potential losses from Hurricanes Helene and Milton. The Fund's independent actuary has projected the range of FHCF losses from Hurricane Helene to be between \$18 million and \$441 million, with an initial point estimate of \$100 million; and a range of \$1.6 billion to \$5.8 billion, with an initial point estimate of \$4.5 billion for Hurricane Milton. Greater detail may be obtained in the October 30, 2024 Claims-Paying Capacity Estimates Report, which can be found on the Fund's website at <https://fhcf.sbafla.com> under "Bonding Program." The Board recognizes this is a good faith estimate and global financial market can be volatile; therefore, changing market conditions can impact the Fund's actual claims-paying capacity either positively or negatively. Current conditions may or may not be the same if and when the Board issues revenue bonds. Participating insurers that rely on these estimates should recognize the potential impact the financial markets can have on the Board's claims-paying ability and plan accordingly.

FINAL ORDER

APPROVING CITY OF KEY WEST ORDINANCE NO. 2024-23

The Florida Department of Commerce (“Department”) hereby issues its Final Order, pursuant to Section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes, approving land development regulations adopted by the City of Key West, Florida (“City”), by Ordinance No. 2024-23 (“Ordinance”).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1.The City is designated within an area of critical state concern. See § 380.0552, Fla. Stat., and Rule 28-36.002, Fla. Admin. Code.

2.The City adopted the Ordinance on August 8, 2024, and rendered it to the Department on September 10, 2024.

3.The Ordinance updates the Historic Architectural Guidelines in the City’s Code of Ordinances by changing the measurement method for fence heights in the Historic District of Key West. Fence heights in the Historic District will now be measured from the front property line’s sidewalk, or from the natural grade of the adjacent public right-of-way if no sidewalk exists.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4.The Department is required to approve or reject land development regulations that are adopted by any local government in an area of critical state concern. See Section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes.

5.“Land development regulations” include local zoning, subdivision, building, and other regulations controlling the development of land. Section 380.031(8), Florida Statutes. The regulations adopted by the Ordinance are land development regulations.

6.The Ordinance is consistent with the City’s Comprehensive Plan generally, as required by Section 163.3177(1), Florida Statutes, and is specifically consistent with Objective 1A-1.2 and Policy 1A-1.2.1.

7.All land development regulations enacted, amended, or rescinded within an area of critical state concern must be consistent with the principles for guiding development for that area. See Section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes. The Principles for Guiding Development for the City are set forth in Rule 28-36.003, Florida Administrative Code.

8.The Ordinance is consistent with the Principles for Guiding Development for the City as a whole, and specifically furthers the following Principles:

(a)Strengthen local government capabilities for managing land use and development; and

(e)Protection of the historical heritage of Key West and the Key West Historical Preservation District.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Commerce finds that Ordinance No. 2024-23 is consistent with the City’s Comprehensive Plan and the Principles for Guiding Development for the City and is hereby APPROVED.

This Final Order becomes final 21 days after publication in the Florida Administrative Register unless a petition is timely filed as described in the Notice of Administrative Rights.
