P.24, 1.6.1. added language at the end of the guidance reading: **Foliar application**

Foliar application of nutrients has become more common for citrus; however, this technique should not be used when heavy rains are likely, to avoid washing nutrients from leaf surfaces. Another important factor for foliar application is to ensure that the pH of the spray solution is between 5.5 and 6.5. This is particularly important in areas where water quality is poor.
