The Bureau of Local Government has set up a web-based electronic reporting program called Local Government Electronic Reporting (“LOGER”) where government entities can submit their annual financial reports. The proposed rule will require that government entities that are required to submit annual financial reports to the Department pursuant to Section 218.32, F.S., shall electronically submit such reports to the Department using the LOGER Program. The submission of annual audit reports required under Section 218.32, F.S., is not affected by the LOGER electronic reporting program.
