Except as provided subparagraph (2)(c)2., a commercial harvester may not harvest or possess within or without Florida Waters <u>more than 50 flounder per trip</u> or land more than 50 flounder <u>per day</u> as incidental bycatch of gear that is being used to lawfully harvest another target species.

2. In or on federal waters adjacent to Florida Waters, a commercial harvester is subject to the following harvest, possession, and landing limits when harvesting flounder as incidental bycatch in shrimp trawls that are being used to

lawfully harvest shrimp in federal waters adjacent to Florida Waters:

a. Beginning December 1 and continuing through October 14 of the following year, the commercial harvesters aboard a vessel may not collectively harvest or possess <del>or land</del> more than 150 flounder <u>per trip or land more than 150 flounder per day</u>.

b. Beginning October 15 and continuing through November 30 each year, the commercial harvesters aboard a vessel may not collectively harvest or possess <del>or land</del> more than 50 flounder per trip or land more than 50 flounder per day.

c. No change.
