Petitioner did not demonstrate that the underlying purpose of the statute would be achieved if a waiver were granted.

Project and Location: Continuing Services Contracts for Modesto A. Maidique Campus (MMC), Biscayne Bay Campus (BBC), Engineering Center (EC), and other properties in South Florida managed by FIU.

Project Description: The general contractor will be the single point of responsibility for performance of the project construction contracts, functioning as an independent contractor, publicly bidding trade contracts.

Continuing Services Contracts are specific projects for renovations, alterations, and additions that have a basic construction budget estimated to be \$500,000.00 or less. Accordingly, the selected firm(s) minimum bonding capacity should be \$500,000.00 per project.

Term of Contract: Up to a maximum of twenty (20) contracts will be awarded to a maximum of twenty (20) different firms as determined by and at the discretion of the Selection Committee. Continuing Services Contracts provide that the consultant will be available on an as-needed basis for the Fiscal Year, July 1 - June 30.

This contract will be awarded for an initial period of one year with the Owner's option to renew the contract, at its sole discretion, for additional one-year periods, however, in no event to exceed a total of five successive years.

Selection Process: Selection of finalists for interviews will be made on the basis of general contractor qualifications, including experience and ability; past experience; bonding capacity; record-keeping/administrative ability, critical path scheduling expertise; cost estimating; cost control ability; quality control capability; qualification of the firm's personnel, and staff and consultants.
