(1) <u>Unless under the direct supervision of a registered nurse</u> or health care practitioner (as defined in Rule 64B9-12.002, F.A.C.), an IV certified LPN, (one who meets the qualifications set forth in Rule 64B9-12.005(1), F.A.C.), shall not perform the following: Aspects of intravenous therapy which are outside the scope of practice of an IV certified licensed practical nurse unless under the direct supervision of the registered nurse or health care practitioner and which shall not be performed or initiated by an IV certified licensed practical nurse without direct supervision include the following: (a) through (d) No change.
