The Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Hotels and Restaurants hereby gives notice: On May 8, 2024 the Division of Hotels and Restaurants received a Petition for a Routine Variance for paragraph 61C-1.004(2)(a), Florida Administrative Code, subsection 61C-4.010(7) Florida Administrative Code and subsection 61C-4.010(6), Florida Administrative Code, and Section 6-40.11. 2017 FDA Food Code from Universal City Development Partners LTD located in Orlando. The above referenced F.A.C. addresses the requirement that at least one accessible bathroom be provided for use by customers and employees. They are requesting to utilize bathrooms located on a different level.

The Petition for this variance was published in Vol. 50/92 on May 9, 2024. The Order for this Petition was signed and approved on May 28, 2024 after a complete review of the variance request, the Division finds that the application of this Rule will create a financial hardship to the food service establishment. Furthermore, the Division finds that the Petitioner meets the burden of demonstrating that the underlying statute has been achieved by the Petitioner ensuring the public bathrooms located on the first floor are maintained in a clean and sanitary manner and are provided with hot and cold running water under pressure, soap, approved hand drying devices, handwash sign and are available during all hours of operation. The Petitioner shall also ensure that directional signage is installed in the main restaurant area clearly stating the location of the bathrooms.

FDOT has identified the need for safety improvements and resurfacing for segments of SR 45 (US 41) in Palmetto, Manatee County.

This project proposes permanent median modifications to reduce conflict points and improve safety at the intersections of SR 45 (US 41) with 16th Avenue E and 61st Street E (Palm View Road). The proposed safety improvements will prohibit left turns from the side streets onto US 41. The median modification is converting a full median opening to a directional median opening. **GENERAL SUBJECT MATTER TO BE CONSIDERED:** The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, has identified the need for improvements along SR 55 (US 19, US 41, S Tamiami Trail). This project involves milling and resurfacing SR 55 from 23rd Ave W to 39th St E to extend the service life of the pavement and implementing safety improvements along the corridor. These improvements include guardrail replacements, sidewalk repair, lighting updates, pedestrian signal replacements, and two median modifications. Generally, the corridor is a multi-lane, divided urban roadway with a design speed ranging from 45 to 55 mph. This corridor passes through suburban residential, commercial, and urban contexts.

**Median Modification 1: 21st St**

SR 55 possesses 2 through lanes in both directions at this location. With high traffic volumes, vehicles struggle to find suitable gaps in traffic to make left turns from 21st St onto SR 55. A safety analysis has identified that a significant number of crashes involving left-turning vehicles occur at this intersection. The proposed median modification will convert the existing full median opening to a directional median opening and will prevent left turns from 21st St onto SR 55. By preventing left turns, the directional median opening will eliminate the safety issues for those looking to cross the road.

**Median Modification 2: 11th St**

SR 55 possesses 3 to 4 through lanes in both directions at this location. The corridor experiences high traffic volumes and the

intersecting legs along 11th St are offset. A safety analysis has identified that a significant number of crashes involving left-turning vehicles as well as fatal pedestrian crashes occur at this intersection. The proposed median modification will convert the existing full median opening to a directional median opening and will prevent left turns from 11th St onto SR 55. By preventing left turns, the directional median opening will eliminate the safety issues as well as provide a pedestrian refuge in the median for those looking to cross the road.
