6A-1.0014           Comprehensive Management Information System

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** To revise existing requirements of the statewide comprehensive management information system to implement changes recommended by school districts and to change state reporting and local recordkeeping procedures for state and/or federal programs as described in the updated FDOE Information Database Requirements. The rule also adopts the updated FDOE Information Database Requirements: Volume I – Automated Student Information System, 2024-25 and Volume II – Automated Staff Information System, 2024-25. The effect maintains compatibility among state and local information systems’ components. The statewide comprehensive management information system provides the data on which the measurement of school improvement and accountability is based.

**SUBJECT AREA TO BE ADDRESSED:** An amendment of the rule is proposed to update the reference to the FDOE Information Database Requirements documents. These documents describe the data elements, procedures and timelines for state reporting, local recordkeeping and statewide records transfer to be implemented by each school district and the department within the statewide comprehensive management information system.

68C-22.011           Citrus and Associated County (Parts of Levy and Hernando) Zones

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** The Commission is considering amendments to portions of the existing Levy County manatee protection rule in the southern portion of the county. The Levy County rule is established under 68C-22.011, F.A.C. (Citrus County chapter). In June 2024, the Commission provided notice to Levy County as provided by §379.2431(2)(f), Florida Statute. The 60-day statutory time requirement expired on August 16, 2024. The proposed rule amendment may amend 68C-22.011(1)(d) from Slow Speed (March 1-August 31) to a 25 MPH All Year zone and amend 68-22.011(1)(a) from a “Caution”/25 MPH All Year Zone to a 25 MPH All Year to be consistent with the surrounding area. The Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Hotels and Restaurants hereby gives notice: On July 22, 2024 the Division of Hotels and Restaurants received a Petition for a Routine Variance for Subparagraph 3-305.11(A)(2), 2017 FDA Food Code, Section 3-305.14, 2017 FDA Food Code, Section 6-202.15, 2017 FDA Food Code, Section 6-202.16, 2017 FDA Food Code, subsection 61C-4.010(1), Florida Administrative Code, and subsection 61C-4.010(6), Florida Administrative Code from Camacho’s Best Tacos LLC. located in Bradenton. The above referenced F.A.C. addresses the requirement for proper handling and dispensing of food. They are requesting to dispense bulk time/temperature control for safety foods from an open air mobile food dispensing vehicle.

The Petition for this variance was published in Vol. 50/155 on August 08, 2024. The Order for this Petition was signed and approved on August 19, 2024. After a complete review of the variance request, the Division finds that the application of this Rule will create a financial hardship to the food service establishment. Furthermore, the Division finds that the Petitioner meets the burden of demonstrating that the underlying statute has been achieved by the Petitioner ensuring that each pan within the steam table is properly covered with an individual lid; the steam table is enclosed within a cabinet with tight-fitting doors, and is protected by an air curtain installed and operated according to the manufacturer’s specifications that protects against flying vermin or other environmental contaminants; all steam table foods must be properly reheated for hot holding at approved commissaries and held hot at the proper minimum temperature per the parameters of the currently adopted FDA Food Code; and steam table food is to be dispensed by the operator with no customer self-service. The Petitioner shall also strictly adhere to the operating procedures and copies of the variance and operating procedures are to be present on the MFDV during all periods of operation.

The Petitioner shall also ensure that the handwash sinks are provided with hot and cold running water under pressure, soap, an approved hand drying device and a handwashing sign.
