#### In re: A LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATION ADOPTED BY LAKE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-04

#### FINAL ORDER APPROVING LAKE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-04

The Florida Department of Commerce ("Commerce") hereby issues its Final Order, pursuant to section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes, approving land development regulations adopted by Lake County, Florida, Ordinance No. 2024-04 (the "Ordinance").

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Green Swamp Area is designated by section 380.0551, Florida Statutes, and Rule 28-26.002, Florida Administrative Code, as an area of critical state concern. Lake County is a local government within the Green Swamp Area.

2. The Ordinance was adopted by Lake County on February 13, 2024, and rendered to Commerce on February 26, 2024.

3. The Ordinance amends Section 3.01.02 of the Lake County Code (the "Code"), Appendix E, Land Development Regulations, to add Mixed-Use Residential District to the Classification of Uses. The Ordinance also amends Section 3.01.03 of the Code, Appendix E, Land Development Regulations, to include Mixed-Use Residential District to the Schedule of Permitted and Conditional Uses chart. In addition, the Ordinance adds a footnote to the Schedule of Permitted and Conditional Uses chart which states that Mixed-Use Residential uses are permitted in commercial and industrial zoning districts if the proposed Mixed-Use Residential developments comply with the requirements of section 125.01055(7)(a), Florida Statutes, and Section 11-40, Lake County Code.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Commerce is required to approve or reject land development regulations that are adopted by any local government in the Green Swamp Area of Critical State Concern. *See* section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes.

5. "Land development regulations" include "local zoning, subdivision, building, and other regulations controlling the development of land." Section 380.031(8), Florida Statutes. The regulations adopted by the Ordinance are land development regulations.

6. The Ordinance is consistent with the Lake County Comprehensive Plan generally, as required by section 163.3177(1), Florida Statutes, and specifically is consistent with Policy I-1.1.4 and Policy I-1.1.5.

7. All land development regulations enacted, amended, or rescinded within an area of critical state concern must be consistent with the principles for guiding development for that area. *See* section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes. The Principles for Guiding Development for the Green Swamp Area of Critical State Concern are set forth in Rule 28-26.003(1), Florida Administrative Code.

8. The Ordinance is consistent with the Principles for Guiding Development for the Green Swamp Area of Critical State Concern as a whole, and specifically furthers the following Principle:

(a): Minimize the adverse impacts of development on resources of the Floridan Aquifer, wetlands, and flood-detention areas.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Commerce finds that Lake County Ordinance No. 2024-04 is consistent with the Lake County Comprehensive Plan and the Principles for Guiding Development for the Green Swamp Area of Critical State Concern and is hereby <u>APPROVED</u>.
