The proposed project includes construction of a screen structure and junction box and associated piping for the installation of a new bar screen to bypass the existing bar screen during storm events. The estimated cost for this project is \$9.86 million. The project may qualify for Clean Water SRF loans composed of federal and state funds. DEP will consider public comments about the environmental impacts of the proposed projects that are postmarked or delivered at the address below within 30 days of
