The Board considered the petition at the duly-noticed video conference public meeting held on June 18, 2025, and found that the Board of Massage Therapy cannot prohibit all of the Hand and Stone franchisees from employing the advertisements containing the trackable telephone numbers as set forth above, but it is the Board's opinion that the seventyfive (75) independently owned and operated franchisees would not be in compliance with Section 480.0465(1), Florida Statutes, if it were to utilize the aforementioned advertising system because the advertisement does not contain and the telephone number that has been provided to the Florida Department of Health as part of the licensing of the establishment. The Board's response to this Petition addresses solely the question propounded by the Petitioner and only addresses issues regarding the practice of Massage Therapy in Florida. The Board's conclusion is based solely on the Board's application of the specific factual circumstances outlined in the Petition and to the pertinent statutory and rule provisions set forth above.
