In accordance with Chapter 2007-306, Laws of Florida, as amended ("Act"), the Babcock Ranch Community Independent Special District ("District") hereby gives notice of its intent to adopt its proposed Memorial Policy, Seasonal Restriction as a Supplement to the Amenity Policy, and the Fees for the Unsolicited Proposals of Public Private Partnerships Policy (collectively, the "Proposed Rules"). The Proposed Rule numbers are 2026-[01], 2026-[02], and 2026-[03]. Prior notice of rule development relative to the Proposed Rules was published in the Florida Administrative Register on October 10. 2025.

A public hearing will be conducted by the Governing Board ("Board") of the District on the following date, time and place to adopt the Proposed Rules:

Pursuant to Section 6(60)(e) of the Act, the Proposed Rules will not require legislative ratification. The Specific grant of rulemaking authority for the adoption of the Proposed Rules includes Section 6(6)(e), Chapter 2007-306, Laws of Florida, as amended. The specific laws implemented in the Proposed Rules include, but are not limited to, Sections 3(3), 6(6)(j), and 6(6)(r), Chapter 2007-306, Laws of Florida, as amended, and Sections 120.54, 120.542, 120.5435, 120.56, 120.69, 120.81, Florida Statutes.

A statement of estimated regulatory costs, as defined in Section 120.541(2), Florida Statutes, has not been prepared relative to

the Proposed Rules. Any person who wishes to provide the District with a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative as provided by Section 120.541(1), Florida Statutes, must do so in writing within twenty-one (21) days after publication of this notice to the District Manager's Office.

The full text of the Proposed Rules is available upon request from the District Manager's Office. The Memorial Policy can be summarized as a memorial program allowing commemorative plaque applications for past residents of the Babcock Ranch community involving incidents that occur on District property and roads. The Seasonal Restriction as a Supplement to the Amenity Policy can be summarized as a seasonal "no-wheels" requirement on a portion of a pathway from Founder's Square to Innovation Tower annually beginning on November 20th through January 15th. The Fees for the Unsolicited Proposals of Public Private Partnerships Policy is to set a rate for the District to evaluate unsolicited proposals received from private entities.

The proposed rates implementing such Proposed Rules are set forth below, which may be adjusted at the public hearing pursuant to discussion by the Board and public comment:
