PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose and effect is to amend the existing rule to interpret and implement section 655.0323, F.S.

SUMMARY: The amendments interpret “a customer” or “prospective customer” to include any person for whom a financial institution has denied service or a business relationship; interpret “score” or “social credit score” to include any consideration of prohibited factors rather than limiting such factors to an actual numerical scoring; clarify complaint processing procedures; and provide the interpretation that a financial institution bears the burden of showing any service denial was due to suspicious activity, if such grounds are claimed.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

The Agency has determined that this will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rule. A SERC has not been prepared by the Agency.

of whether to deny, cancel, suspend, terminate, or make available any service, action, or business relationship.

(2) For the purposes of administering s. 655.0323(2)(d), F.S., the term “score” or “social credit score” is not limited to a numerical valuation and includes any assessment, appraisal, rating, or consideration.

(3)(1) A person or entity who If a customer or member of a financial institution suspects that a such financial institution has acted in violation of s. 655.0323(2), Florida Statutes, the customer or member may file a complaint with the Office. Complaints must be submitted by the aggrieved party within 30 days of the alleged violating action on by completing and submitting to the Office Form OFR-U-3231, Complaint, effective 08-2024, herein incorporated by reference and available at

<https://www.flrules.org/Gateway/reference.asp?No=Ref-16902> on the Office’s website at www.flofr.gov. Complaints not complying with this rule or otherwise not meeting statutory requirements will not be processed by the Office under s. 655.0323, Florida Statutes. A complaint is barred if not submitted to the Office within 30 days of the action that is described within the complaint.

(4)(2) After the Office’s receipt of a facially sufficient complaint, it will forward notice of the complaint along with a copy to the subject financial institution which A financial institution that receives a notice of complaint from the Office must, within 90 calendar days of receiving such notice, complete and submit to the Office Form OFR-U-3232, Complaint Response Report, effective 08-2024, herein incorporated by reference and available at <https://www.flrules.org/Gateway/reference.asp?No=Ref-16903> and on the Office’s website at www.flofr.gov.

(a) A financial institution claiming any action or inaction was due to suspicious activity, as defined in s. 655.50(3), F.S., must clearly indicate such and provide sufficient information to substantiate such claim along with its complaint response report.

(b) If the Office determines that the complaint response report does not indicate and provide sufficient information that the financial institution’s action was taken on the basis of suspicious activity as defined in s. 655.50(3), F.S., the Office will continue to investigate the financial institution’s action and determine whether it has acted in violation of law.

See Sections 403.0741, and 403.703, F.S., for definitions of the following terms: “Closure,” “County,” “Department,” “Grease interceptor or grease trap,” “Grease waste,” “Operation,” “Originator,” “Person,” “Processing,” “Recycling,” “Service manifest,” “Solid waste,” “Solid waste management facility.” The following words and phrases used in this chapter shall have the following meaning:

(4) “Hauler” means a person who removes and transports grease waste for disposal, processing, or recycling. ~~This definition excludes self-cleaners as defined in this chapter.~~

(6) “Self-cleaner” means an originator who removes grease waste from a grease trap that has a storage capacity of 55 gallons or less and that is located at their establishment, who subsequently dewateres the grease waste, places the grease waste into a container, and transports the grease waste for disposal at ~~disposes the containerized dewatered grease waste in a waste receptacle for transport to a permitted solid waste management facility authorized to accept grease waste or a certified grease waste disposal facility.~~

62-705.300 Grease Waste Hauler Requirements.

(1) The licensure requirements of this section apply to haulers, as defined in subsection 62-705.200(4), F.A.C. The licensure requirements of subsection 62-705.300(2), F.A.C., do not apply to self-cleaners as defined in subsection 62-705.200(6), F.A.C. Self-cleaners are still required to comply with all other applicable requirements of this rule and all applicable statutory provisions contained in section 403.0741, F.S.

(2) A hauler shall submit an application using Form 62-705.300(2) ~~62-705.900(4)~~ Application for Grease Waste Hauler License, effective date December ~~November~~ 2025, hereby adopted and incorporated by reference, to obtain or renew a hauler license to remove grease waste. Copies of this form can be obtained from the Department’s website or by contacting the Department of Environmental Protection, Solid Waste Section, MS 4565, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-2400, or the form can be obtained at <http://flrules.org/Gateway/reference.asp?No=Ref-18593>. Upon receipt of a complete and accurate form, the Department shall

issue to each hauler a license which shall be valid until April 1 of the following year. Existing haulers must submit an Application for Grease Waste Hauler License within 180 days from the effective date of this rule. Haulers must submit a renewal Application for Grease Waste Hauler License by March 1 annually. A new hauler shall submit an Application for Grease Waste Hauler License at least 30 days before the hauler intends to begin removal of grease waste.

(3) A hauler must document the removal and disposal of grease waste using Form 62-705.300(3) ~~62-705.900(2)~~ Grease Waste Service Manifest (Service Manifest), effective date December ~~November~~ 2025, hereby adopted and incorporated by reference. The Department has determined the revisions to the proposed rule contained within this notice will not increase regulatory costs. However, the proposed rule revisions require that the previously prepared Statement of Estimated Regulatory Costs be substantially revised to reflect the new proposed rule language set forth in this notice. Therefore, the Department prepared a revised Statement of Estimated Regulatory Costs (SERC). The revised SERC estimates regulatory costs on self-cleaners, originators, and haulers. The revised SERC also excludes references to inspecting entities as the portion of the proposed rule governing inspecting entities is being withdrawn. The Department has determined that self-cleaners are not expected to create any significant threat to the environment or public health through the management of grease waste. Therefore, the changes to the proposed rule will not require them to apply for a hauler license if they transport and dispose of grease waste at a permitted or certified disposal facility. Self-cleaners are required to comply with all applicable provisions of 403.0741, F.S. Supervision is the relationship between the qualified supervisor and intern that promotes the development of responsibility, skills, knowledge, attitudes and adherence to ethical, legal and regulatory standards in the practice of clinical social work, marriage and family therapy and mental health counseling. Supervision is contact between an intern and a supervisor during which the intern appraises the supervisor of the diagnosis and treatment of each client, client cases are discussed, the supervisor provides the intern with oversight and guidance in

diagnosing, treating and dealing with clients, and the supervisor evaluates the intern's performance.

(7) Notwithstanding subsections (3) and (4) above a qualified supervisor may utilize face-to-face electronic methods, including telephone only communication, to conduct all supervisory sessions for internship hours if the qualified supervisor determines, through their professional judgment, that such methods are not detrimental to the registered intern's clients and are necessary to protect the health, safety, or welfare of the ~~qualified~~ ~~qualified~~ supervisor, the registered intern, or both. Any clinical hours obtained via face-to-face psychotherapy by electronic means shall be considered clinical hours for the purpose of meeting internship requirements.
