The modifications became effective on July 1, 2025, in accordance with Chapter 2025-114, Laws of Florida.

SUMMARY: Updates are being made to the incorporated Form DH-MQA-5101, Mobile Opportunity by Interstate Licensure

Endorsement (MOBILE), pursuant to changes to s. 456.0145, F.S. The modifications became effective on July 1, 2025, in accordance with Chapter 2025-114, Laws of Florida.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

20ER25-1 Grapefruit Maturity Standards - Processed SPECIFIC REASONS FOR FINDING AN IMMEDIATE DANGER TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY OR WELFARE: Section 120.54(4)(b), Florida Statutes, states that those rules pertaining to perishable agricultural commodities shall be included in the definition of rules relating to the public health, safety, or welfare. Section 601.111, Florida Statutes

explicitly states that an emergency may be created by hurricanes that affect a substantial part of the citrus industry. An emergency rule adopted under that subsection must contain an expiration date of no longer than one year after its effective date.

Due to adverse growing conditions over the last 17 years due to Huanglongbing ("HLB" or "Greening") disease, significant amounts of the Florida grapefruit crop in the 2025-2026 season will have a minimum ratio of total soluble solids to anhydrous citric acid below the maturity requirements established in rule. The inability to utilize this fruit would cause economic waste by allowing good and safe food to be ruled immature and will harm growers financially due to the inability to sell the fruit that does not meet the current minimum ratio of solids to citric acid. After discussing the matter at the regular meeting and hearing in Bartow, Florida on October 22, 2025, the Florida Citrus Commission finds that there exist conditions which could cause a substantial portion of the processed crop to fail maturity requirements. The commission unanimously voted to adopt Emergency Rule 20ER25-1, lowering the minimum Brix standard to be no less than 7.0 from October 24, 2025, through December 31, 2025, and removing the minimum ratio of total soluble solids to anhydrous citric acid on all grapefruit including field ruin and eliminations from October 24, 2025, through July 31, 2026.

REASON FOR CONCLUDING THAT THE PROCEDURE IS FAIR UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES: Adequate notice procedures were used by the Department of Citrus to inform the public and the Florida citrus industry of the pending adoption of Emergency Rule 20ER25-1 lowering the brix and removing the minimum ratio of total soluble solids to anhydrous citric acid requirements for processed grapefruit including field run and eliminations, in that notice was sent via email on October 21, 2025, of the emergency rulemaking to take place on October 22, 2025, at the regularly scheduled meeting to members of the Florida Citrus Commission, all industry organizations, the Florida Press Corps and other interested persons.

SUMMARY: Emergency rule 20ER25-1 lowering the minimum Brix requirement for processed grapefruit for the period beginning October 24, 2025, through December 31, 2025, and removing the minimum ratio of total soluble solids to anhydrous citric acid for all grapefruit including field run and eliminations for the period beginning October 24, 2025, through July 31, 2026, both dates inclusive.

Due to adverse growing conditions over the last 17 years due to Huanglongbing ("HLB" or "Greening") disease, significant amounts of the Florida orange crop in the 2025-2026 season will have a minimum ratio of total soluble solids to anhydrous citric acid below the maturity requirements established in rule. The inability to utilize this fruit would cause economic waste by allowing good and safe food to be ruled immature and will harm growers financially due to the inability to sell the fruit that does not meet the current minimum ratio of solids to citric acid. After discussing the matter at the regular meeting and hearing in Bartow, Florida on October 22, 2025, the Florida Citrus Commission finds that there exist conditions which could cause a substantial portion of the processed orange crop to fail maturity requirements. The commission unanimously voted to adopt Emergency Rule 20ER25-2, removing the minimum ratio of total soluble solids to anhydrous citric acid on processed oranges including field run and eliminations, and those oranges must have a Brix value of no less than 7.0.

REASON FOR CONCLUDING THAT THE PROCEDURE IS FAIR UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES: Adequate notice procedures were used by the Department of Citrus to inform the

public and the Florida citrus industry of the pending adoption of Emergency Rule 20ER25-2 adjusting the minimum ratio of total soluble solids to anhydrous citric acid requirements for processed oranges and lowering the Brix value, in that notice was sent via email on October 21, 2025 of the emergency rulemaking to take place on October 22, 2025, at the regularly scheduled meeting to members of the Florida Citrus Commission, all industry organizations, the Florida Press Corps and other interested persons.

SUMMARY: Emergency rule 20ER25-2 removing the minimum ratio of total soluble solids to anhydrous citric acid and lowering the minimum Brix requirement for processed oranges including field run and eliminations for the period beginning October 24, 2025, through July 31, 2026, both dates inclusive.

(a) A winner of a \$1,000,000 prize may choose one of two payment options for receiving his/her prize: One-Time Cash Payment or Annual Payments. The winner has sixty (60) days from the date of ticket validation to file a claim choosing the One-Time Cash Payment. If a winner does not choose the One-Time Cash Payment within the sixty (60) day timeframe, the Annual Payments method will be applied. Once the winner files a claim and exercises his/her chosen option, the election of that option shall be final. The Annual Payments method will also be final when it is applied due to a winner not making his/her payment election within sixty (60) days after ticket validation.

(b) A winner of a \$1,000,000 prize who elects the One-Time Cash Payment shall receive a single cash payment of \$606,700.00, less applicable federal income tax withholding.

(c) A winner of a \$1,000,000 prize who elects the Annual Payments option, or has it applied, shall receive \$40,000.00 per year for twenty-five (25) years, less applicable federal tax withholding.

THE FULL TEXT OF THE EMERGENCY RULE IS:

53ER25-56 HOLIDAY CASH Bonus Play.

(1) General Promotion/Bonus Play Description.

(a) Promotion/Bonus Play Period. Beginning October 27, 2025 and ending January 11, 2026 ("Promotion Period"), the Florida Lottery will conduct the HOLIDAY CASH Bonus Play ("Promotion" or "Bonus Play").

(b) Eligible Tickets. Tickets eligible for Promotion entry are: Non-winning Game Number 1609, \$10,000 Holiday Cash; Game Number 1610, \$50,000 Holiday Cash; Game Number 1611, \$250,000 Holiday Cash; Game Number 1612, \$500,000 Holiday Cash; and Game Number 1613, \$1,000,000 Holiday Cash Scratch-Off tickets; and any CASH POPTM ticket (winning and non-winning) purchased during the Promotion Period. CASH POP tickets that are part of GROUPER® Super Sampler purchases are eligible. Winning Holiday Cash tickets are not eligible. Continuation and Canceled tickets are not eligible. Training tickets and tickets with invalid ticket numbers are not eligible. Tickets meeting the criteria described in this paragraph are hereafter referred to as "Eligible" tickets.

- (c) Drawing Prizes. During the Promotion Period available Promotion Drawing prizes are: \$1,000; \$5,000; and \$20,000.
- (d) Coupons. During the Promotion Period, the Florida Lottery will randomly award Coupons that are redeemable for cash prizes. Available Coupon cash prizes are: \$100, \$250, and \$500. Coupons for a BOGO (Buy One Get One) \$1 CASH POP ticket will also be randomly awarded.
 - (2) How to Enter.

(a) To enter an Eligible ticket into a Promotion Drawing, a player may use the Florida Lottery's website at floridalottery.com or use the Florida Lottery's Mobile Convenience App ("App"). Only Eligible tickets purchased during a given Drawing Entry Period can be entered during that Drawing Entry Period. For example, tickets purchased during the first Drawing Entry Period may be entered during the time frame for the first Drawing Entry Period but cannot be entered during the second or third Drawing Entry Periods. See subsection (5), below, for Drawing Entry Period dates.

1. Website. On the home page of the Florida Lottery's website, players click on the Promotions tab and select the HOLIDAY CASH Bonus Play. Players will manually enter the 24-digit ticket number shown on Eligible Holiday Cash tickets or the 19-digit ticket number on Eligible CASH POP tickets on the ticket entry page to collect entries as described in subsection (3), below.

- 2. App. On the App, players select the Holiday Cash Bonus Play under the Promotions section. A Promotions button is located on the main menu and on the bottom navigation bar. Players may scan the barcode on the bottom of a ticket or may manually enter the 24-digit ticket number (Eligible Holiday Cash tickets) or 19-digit ticket number (Eligible CASH POP tickets) on the ticket entry page to collect entries as described in subsection (3), below.
- 3. Deleted Accounts. If a player deletes his/her account, whether through the App or on the Florida Lottery's website, all account data, including ticket entries, associated with the email address used to register his/her account will also be deleted. Any entries earned will not be entered into a drawing. A player's account cannot be reactivated using the email associated with the deactivated account. Should a player establish a new account utilizing a different email address, account data, including ticket entries, cannot be transferred to the newly established account. Tickets entered under the prior account cannot be re-entered utilizing the newly created account.
- 4. Regardless of whether a player chooses to participate in the Promotion by using the web browser or the App, the following provisions shall apply:
 - a. a player will be prompted to either register or login;
- b. the player must use the same account login information to enter tickets;
- c. the player will only be required to register one time; and d. the player's entry history will be cumulative among the entry platforms.
- (b) Any attempt by a player to use more than one account by using multiple or different email addresses, identities, registrations, logins, or any other methods will subject the player and any associated entries to disqualification. In the event a player wins a prize, the name a player uses to register must match the name shown on his/her identification used to make a claim, except for a person who has made a legal name change. A person who has made a legal name change must provide a copy of a marriage certificate/judgment/court order, as applicable, as proof of a differing name. Fictitious names and business names will not be accepted and shall subject the player and any associated entries to disqualification.
- (c) The odds of winning depend on the number of entries in a drawing. All entries are subject to validation by the Florida Lottery and will be disqualified if eligibility requirements are not met.
- (d) Lottery tickets should not be mailed to the Lottery for entry into a drawing. Tickets received in the mail by the Florida Lottery for entry into the Promotion will not be entered into a drawing and will not be returned.
 - (3) Earning Entries into the Promotion.

(a) To earn entries into a Promotion Drawing, a player may enter ticket numbers by scanning the barcode on the bottom of an Eligible ticket using his or her mobile device or by manually entering the 24-digit ticket number (Eligible Holiday Cash tickets) or the 19-digit number (CASH POP tickets) on the website or the Mobile App. A player may earn multiple entries during an entry period. A player may enter a maximum of 200 tickets per day. Each ticket number can only be entered one time and cannot be entered again for another drawing. Players may enter Eligible ticket/s into the Bonus Play at any time during the Promotion Period, except that entry capabilities on the website and App will be unavailable from 12 a.m. through 6 a.m. ET due to routine maintenance and may be unavailable at other times if there are technical difficulties. Entries must be made by 11:59:59 p.m. (ET) on the last day of a Drawing Entry Period to be entered into that drawing. See subsection (5) for Drawing Entry Periods.

*Bonus Entries. When the entire Holiday Cash Family of Games (#1609, 1610, 1611, 1612, and 1613) is entered during the same Drawing Entry Period, fifty (50) bonus entries will be earned. The entire Holiday Cash Family does not need to be entered simultaneously but must be entered during the same Drawing Entry Period to earn the bonus entries. Multiple Holiday Cash families may be entered; each complete family entered during the same Drawing Entry Period will receive 50 additional entries. There will be three (3) four (4) day periods, identified in the table, below, during which players may purchase any PICK Daily GamesTM ticket (PICK 2TM, PICK 3TM, PICK 4TM, and PICK 5TM (hereafter, collectively "PICK")) to receive a Promo Code to earn twenty-five (25) bonus entries. A Promo Code will print on the PICK ticket purchased. Various promo codes will be available for each of the three (3) Drawing Entry Periods during the Bonus Play via Florida Lottery social media channels (Facebook, Instagram, X (formerly Twitter)); Gas Station TV (GSTV); In-Store Animation L-Bars; and digital overlays on Online Video ad placements. The promo codes must be entered at the time a ticket is entered, can only be used one time, and can only be used during the designated Drawing Entry Period.
- (4) Coupons. Upon entry of any Eligible ticket, a player may be awarded a Coupon for either a cash prize or a BOGO CASH POP ticket. A Nth generation process, across all entries, will be used to make random Coupon awards. Any Coupon/s not awarded during the Promotion will not be otherwise awarded.

(7) Winner Notification - Drawing Prizes. The Florida Lottery will attempt to notify each winner by telephone or email using the contact information provided in the winner's registration data within one business day after drawing winners are posted on the Florida Lottery's website. The Lottery deems the winner's registration data as the winner's official contact information. Issuing an email or leaving a telephone message on voicemail, if available, shall constitute notification. The Lottery will not attempt to further locate a winner if attempts to reach the winner by telephone or email are unsuccessful. If the Lottery is unable to have contact by telephone or email with a winner within ten (10) calendar days of the date the winners are posted on the Lottery's website, the winner will forfeit his or her right to claim the prize and the Lottery will select an alternate winner in accordance with subsection (5), above. If the Lottery is unable to have contact by email or telephone with the alternate winner within ten (10) calendar days of the date of notification, the alternate winner will forfeit his or her right to claim the prize and the Lottery will select the next alternate winner. This process will continue until an alternate is contacted or the Lottery has exhausted the list of alternates due to unsuccessful notification attempts or due to failure by a winner or an alternate winner to timely provide required claim documentation as set forth in subsection (8), below. The Lottery is not responsible or liable for system failures of any sort or type, including, but not exclusively, computer failures, email service failures, and telephone failures. If a prize cannot be awarded for any reason, the prize will not otherwise be awarded.

(8) How to Claim a Drawing Prize.

(a) To claim a prize won in a Promotion drawing, a winner must submit to the Florida Lottery a completed Winner Claim Form DOL-173-2, Revised 2/2023, or Spanish Winner Claim Form DOL-173-2S, Revised 2/2023, and a copy of acceptable identification as set forth in the Florida Lottery's rule governing payment of prizes. (c) The required documents must be received by the Florida Lottery no later than ten (10) calendar days after the Lottery has first notified the winner by telephone (notification by telephone is deemed complete by leaving a voicemail message, if available) or email (issuing an email constitutes notification). If the Lottery does not receive the required documents from a winner by the tenth calendar day after notification, the winner will forfeit his or her right to claim the prize and the Lottery will award the prize to an alternate winner as described in subsection (5), above. The same timeframe for a winner to return required documentation to the Lottery shall apply to an alternate winner. Should a player use a mailing service (U.S. Mail, FedEx, UPS, etc.) to submit documents, the risk of mailing remains with the player. The Lottery is not responsible for delays in mailing or lost/stolen mail.

(9) Award of Drawing Prizes. Upon the Florida Lottery's timely receipt of a winner's required documentation, the Lottery will award the prize to that winner, subject to applicable federal tax withholding and analysis for State-Owed Debt and Child Support Debt.

(10) Analysis for State-Owed Debt and Child Support Debt – Drawing Prizes. Prior to the award of drawing prizes, winners will be analyzed for child support debt and Florida state-owed debt. If more than one prize is awarded to a winner, a separate analysis shall occur prior to payment of each prize. If the winner is identified as owing outstanding debt to any state agency or owes child support, the debt will be offset in accordance with Section 24.115, Fla. Stat. If the debt is less than the amount of the cash prize, the balance of the prize, less applicable income tax withholding on the full prize amount, and after the debt is offset shall be awarded. If the debt is greater than any cash

prize, the entire prize amount, after applicable income tax withholding on the full prize amount, will be applied to the outstanding debt.

- (11) Taxes. All federal, state, and/or local taxes and/or other costs and fees on all prizes will be the responsibility of winners. For \$20,000 prizes, and pursuant to applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Service code, federal income taxes will be withheld at a rate of twenty-four percent (24%) for U. S. citizens and legal U. S. residents and at a rate of thirty percent (30%) for nonresident winners. SUMMARY: This emergency rule sets forth the provisions for the Retailer Incentive – November 1, 2025 - January 11, 2026. THE PERSON TO BE CONTACTED REGARDING THE EMERGENCY RULE IS: Minerva A. Simpson, Attorney, Department of the Lottery, 250 Marriott Drive, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-4011

THE FULL TEXT OF THE EMERGENCY RULE IS:

<u>53ER25-57 Retailer Incentive – November 1, 2025 –</u> January 11, 2026.

(1) General Bonus Incentive Provisions.

(a) Incentive Period: November 1, 2025 through January 11, 2026 (11:59:59 p.m., ET, on January 11, 2026), dates inclusive, and subject to retailer operating hours.

(b) Eligible Games: All Scratch-Off games and PICK Daily GamesTM (PICK 2TM, PICK 3TM, PICK 4TM, and PICK 5TM) (hereafter, and collectively, "PICK"). PICK sales will include Fireball sales. "All" Scratch-Off games include any Scratch-Off game available, or had been available, for sale during the respective timeframes, defined in subparagraph (1)(c)2., below.

- (c) There are two (2) comparison periods; One for all Scratch-Off game sales and one for PICK sales.
- <u>1.PICK Daily Games: November 1 30, 2025 (hereafter "2025") to be compared to November 2 December 1, 2024</u> (hereafter "2024").
- 2. All Scratch-Off Games: December 1, 2025 January 11, 2026 (hereafter "2025") to be compared to December 2, 2024 January 12, 2025 (hereafter "2024").
 - (d) Retailer Eligibility Requirements.
- 1. This Incentive is open to Florida Lottery Retailers that have been actively and continuously contracted, with no contractual breaches, from November 2, 2024 through and including January 11, 2026. Retailers must have draw game sales on or before November 2, 2024 and must also be active and selling tickets for the full duration of both the 2024 and 2025 periods.
- 2. Temporary suspensions (for other than contractual breaches) do not disqualify a Retailer location as long it has recorded sales for the 2024 and 2025 periods.
- 3. Ticket sales through vending machines will be counted/included. However, Retailers who sell tickets only through vending machines are excluded from participating in this Incentive.

- 4. If a Retailer has more than one (1) location, each location will be considered independently. Each location must meet the eligibility and qualification requirements set forth in this rule. Retailers having a change in ownership between the 2024 periods and the 2025 periods are not eligible.
 - (2) Scratch-Off Game Provisions.
- (a) Funds Availability. Funds available for the Scratch-Off portion of this Incentive are \$250,000. This sum will be allocated into one hundred (100) \$1,000 Bonus awards and three hundred (300) \$500 Bonus awards. If all Bonus awards are not made pursuant to this Incentive, they will not otherwise be awarded.
- (b) Retailers' "2025" Scratch-Off sales will be measured against their "2024" Scratch-Off sales.
- (c) Retailer Qualification Requirements. In addition to eligibility requirements, Retailers must satisfy the qualifications set forth herein.
- 1. Scratch-Off Games Launching December 8, 2025. All four (4) Scratch-Off games launching on December 8, 2025 (Game Number 1615, Happy New Year 2026; Game Number 1616, LoteriaTM, Game Number 1617, Bonus Box Bingo; and Game Number 1618, Diamond Doubler Cashword) ticket books must be activated between 6:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. (ET) on December 8, 2025. (Sales for Games 1615, 1616, 1617, and 1618 begin December 8, 2025.) A minimum of one (1) book must be activated for each of the four games. If a Retailer satisfies all other requirements set forth in this Rule and does not activate all four of the games' ticket books as described herein, the Retailer is not eligible to receive a Bonus award.
- 2. Minimum Sales. A Retailer must have: A minimum of \$300 in total Scratch-Off sales for the 2024 period; a minimum of \$600 in total Scratch-Off sales for the 2025 period; and based on their assigned Tier, the minimum sales percentage increase for the 2025 period over the 2024 period, as set forth in the table in subparagraph (2)(c)4., below. (A Retailer must have the minimum Scratch-Off sales for both the 2024 and 2025 periods to qualify for a Bonus award, irrespective of the percentage increase over the 2024 period.)
- 3. Based on all Scratch-Off 2024 period sales, Retailers will be placed into one of four Tiers (Tiers 1 4) (reference the table in subparagraph (2)(c)4., below). The 2024 period Scratch-Off sales will be compared to the 2025 period Scratch-Off sales.
- 4. Tiers, Total Scratch-Off Ticket Sales for the 2024 period, and Minimum Sales Percentage Increase for the 2025 Period over the 2024 Period are set forth in the table below:

*By Tier, the top number of performing Retailers will be awarded a \$1,000 bonus; the next grouping of top performing Retailers will be awarded a \$500 bonus. For example, for Tier 1 Retailers, the thirty-two (32) best performing Retailers will receive \$1,000; the next twenty-five (25) best performing Retailers will receive \$500. Percentages will be calculated to two (2) decimal points. In the event of a tie, an Incentive bonus will be awarded based on the highest percentage increase of total PICK sales during the entire Incentive Period (November 1, 2025 through and including January 11, 2026). If a second tie-breaker is required, an Incentive bonus will be awarded based on the highest percentage increase of total Lottery sales (all draw game and all Scratch-Offs) during the entire Incentive Period (November 1, 2025 through and including January 11, 2026).

- 6. Scratch-Off sales will be measured based on book settlement. The Lottery reserves the right to review book settlement and return practices to ensure validity of final results.
 - (3) PICK Daily Games Provisions.
- (a) State-wide PICK sales for the 2024 and 2025 periods, defined in subparagraph (1)(c)1., will be determined. The two amounts will be compared against each other to determine the state-wide percentage change in sales (2024 period versus the 2025 period).
- (b) Each eligible Retailer's PICK sales for the 2024 period and the 2025 period will also be calculated to determine the percentage change in sales.
- (c) A Retailer's percentage change in sales will be compared to the state-wide percentage change in sales for the

2024 and 2025 periods. If a Retailer's percentage change exceeds the state-wide percentage, the Retailer will receive a ten percent (10%) sales commission on the incremental PICK sales for the 2025 period (November 1 – 30, 2025) over the 2024 period (November 2 – December 1, 2024). (I.e. A Retailer's sales in excess of the overall State's sales will earn a Retailer 10% commission for that amount. Sales up to, and including, the State's amount will earn the standard commission. For example, A Retailer has a 10% increase in PICK sales for the 2025 period over the 2024 period. State-wide sales increased 7%. The Retailer would receive a 10% commission on the 3% difference.)

(d) Any Retailer not exceeding the state-wide sales percentage change (2024 period versus the 2025 period) will not receive PICK bonus sales commissions, and the standard sales commission will apply.

(4) Payment Provisions.

(a) Bonus Awards Deemed Compensation. All incentive bonuses awarded are deemed compensation and will be reported to the IRS (Internal Revenue Service).

(b) Bonus Award Payments.

1. Scratch-Off earnings will be paid to Retailers via check. For any check that has been uncashed within 90 days of issuance, and if the Retailer is in arrearage to the Florida Lottery, the funds issued for the Incentive payment shall be applied to the balance owed.

- 2. PICK earnings will be paid to Retailers via an adjustment to their Weekly Settlement Report at the end of the Incentive Period.
- (c) A Retailer must be active and in good contractual standing at the time a Bonus award is distributed in order to receive its Bonus award; this is irrespective of whether the Retailer would otherwise qualify.
- (d) Bonus awards that are not awarded or are unable to be awarded for any reason will not otherwise be awarded.
- (e) If there is a conflict with a provision set forth in this Rule and any promotional materials, including, but not limited to, point of sale, television, radio, and print advertising, and other promotional media/materials, the terms of this Rule shall prevail.

The petition, filed July 24, 2025, sought a variance from section 2.5.4 of the Child Care Facility Handbook, incorporated by reference in subsection 65C-22.001(6), Florida Administrative Code, which requires child care facility vehicles to have child reminder alarm systems that sound within one minute of the ignition turning off. Petitioner sought a variance for its two vehicles whose alarm systems sounded after four minutes. The timing of those systems does not align with the Department's established safety expectations. 65C-46.011 Personnel and Staffing Requirements

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on August 28, 2025, the Department of Children and Families, received a petition for waiver from subparagraph 65C-46.011(8)(a)1., Florida Administrative Code, from Johnette Leonard of Unity House. This rule requires executive directors of child-caring facilities to have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and at least three years of experience in management or supervision.
