Stat.; clearly define and update terms used throughout the chapter; delete obsolete forms and adopt new forms and wrecker zone maps for incorporation by reference; delete references to repealed rules and statutes; update requirements applicable to wreckers, equipment, and wrecker operators; and update grounds and procedures for denial of inclusion on, or removal or suspension from, the wrecker operator system. The effect will be to provide clear guidance to applicants and participants in the wrecker operator system.
