PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose of the amendment to Rule 59G-4.252, Florida Administrative Code, (F.A.C.), is to incorporate by reference the Florida Medicaid Diabetic Supply Services Coverage Policy, _____ and update the rule text. The amendment clarifies policy language, defines Maximum Allowable Cost, revises the Florida Medicaid Preferred Product List, and removes the sunset provision from the rule text pursuant to Chapter 2025-189, Laws of Florida (L.O.F.).

68D-24.109 Withlacoochee River Boating Restricted Areas

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: These amendments reflect updated National Weather Service (NWS) data collection methods for existing boating-restricted areas (designated as Idle Speed No Wake during times of flooding) along the Withlacoochee River. The NWS has designated an "action stage" for three of the four water level gauges FWC monitors on the river. The action stage represents the level of a rising stream at which mitigation measures become necessary in preparation for possible significant hydrologic activity. Action stages will replace the current outdated numerical measurements to allow for consistency and simplicity. For the fourth gauge, the rule will be amended to reflect NOAA's revised data collection methods. In addition, amendments will remove all Withlacoochee River closure provisions from this rule as Florida law does not authorize the Commission to establish closure areas.

SUBJECT AREA TO BE ADDRESSED: Withlacoochee River from Big Flat Rock south to CSX Railway Trestle lying within Citrus, Hernando, Marion, and Sumter counties.

The S.R. 70 over Kissimmee River Bridge, Bridge No. 910001 (8HG01236/8OB00336) is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) under Criterion C in the area of Engineering as an example of a removable span bridge. Based on an evaluation of all PD&E Study alternatives, it is not feasible to keep the historic bridge in place and the proposed improvements require the replacement of this bridge. The State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) concurred with the findings on July 17, 2024. Subsequently, a Section 106 Case Study was prepared in which the FDOT applied the Criteria of Adverse Effect to this historical property. The SHPO concurred with these findings on September 22, 2025.

Local historical societies were contacted on July 21, 2025 to provide information on the adverse effect to the bridge and to

request feedback that will be considered for the development of mitigative measures.

The proposed undertaking will result in an “adverse effect” to the NRHP-eligible SR 70 over Kissimmee River Bridge, Bridge No. 910001 (8HG01236/8OB00336). Proposed mitigation strategies being discussed include the salvage of the existing bridge plaque and relocation to a new location, an educational exhibit to be placed in close proximity to the bridge location, and a Historic American Engineering Record document. Your input is sought concerning the undertaking’s adverse effect to the resource and proposed mitigation.
