PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The Department (DEP) is initiating rulemaking to revise rule forms contained in Rule 62-620.910, F.A.C. The rule will not increase any fees, business costs, personnel costs, will not decrease profit opportunities, and will not require any specialized knowledge to comply. This change will not increase any direct or indirect regulatory costs. Hence, the Board determined that a Statement of Estimated Regulatory Costs (SERC) was not necessary and that the rule will not require ratification by the Legislature. (1) When the Board finds an applicant, licensee, registered intern, provisional licensee, or certificate holder whom it regulates under Chapter 491, F.S., or a telehealth provider registered under section 456.47(4), F.S., has committed any of the acts set forth in Section 456.072(1) or 491.009(1), F.S., it shall issue a final order imposing appropriate penalties as recommended in the following disciplinary guidelines.
