Upon receipt of an application for an Education/Exhibition SAL to collect a giant manta ray or queen conch, FWC staff will review the application based on the general and specific evaluation criteria in rule, including completeness of information and applicant eligibility. If staff determine that an eligible applicant submitted a complete application in accordance with the evaluation criteria, staff will present the application to the Commissioners for their consideration. An Education/Exhibition SAL to collect a giant manta ray or a queen conch may only be issued following a vote of the Commissioners to approve the application. Applicants are strongly encouraged to attend any public meeting at which the Commissioners will consider their application.

If the National Marine Fisheries Service issues regulations under Section 4(d) of the U.S. ESA (commonly referred to as a 4(d) rule) that prohibit the FWC from authorizing the collection of a species listed in this section for the purposes of education or exhibition, the FWC shall revoke existing collection authorizations and shall not issue new authorizations for the collection of that species for education or exhibition purposes pursuant to an Education/Exhibition SAL.
