It is the intent of the Board of Governors in regulation and the State Board of Education in rule to facilitate articulation and seamless integration of the education system by agreeing to the provisions of this articulation agreement, pursuant to Section 1007.23, F.S. The South Florida Water Management District (District) hereby gives notice: On June 11, 2026, the District's Governing Board issued SFWMD Order No. 2026-055-DAO-ROW to Broward County Parks and Recreation Division (Application No. 250804-55599). The petition for waiver was received by the District on August 19, 2025. Notice of receipt of the petition requesting the waiver was published in the Florida Administrative Register, Vol. 51/163 on August 21, 2025. No public comment was received on this item. This Order provides a waiver of the District's criteria to allow a kiosk, bench, trash receptacle and an entry sign within the east right of way located adjacent to U.S. 27, approximately two miles north of I-75. Specifically, the Order grants a waiver from subsections 40E-6.011(4) and (6), Fla. Admin. Code, which prohibits above-ground facilities within 40 feet of the top of bank, and from
