FINAL ORDER

APPROVING MONROE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 014-2026

The Florida Department of Commerce (“Department”) hereby issues its Final Order, pursuant to sections 380.05(6) and 380.0552(9), Florida Statutes, approving land development regulations adopted by the Monroe County, Florida (the “County”), Ordinance No. 014-2026 (the “Ordinance”).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Florida Keys Area is designated by section 380.0552, Florida Statutes, as an area of critical state concern. The County is a local government within the Florida Keys Area.

2. The Ordinance was adopted by the City on May 20, 2026, and rendered to the Department June 22, 2026.

3. The Ordinance amends the definitions under Section 101-1 to define a certified recovery residence and a certified recovery residence administrator. The Ordinance also includes certified recovery residence in the definition of institutional-residential use.

4. The Ordinance also amends Section 102-187(b), entitled “Variances Granted by the Planning Commission”, to include requests for reasonable accommodations to establish a certified recovery residence as one of the variances the Planning Commission is authorized to grant. Additionally, the Ordinance adds subsection (e) to Section 102-187 which sets forth the process for requesting reasonable accommodations to establish a certified recovery residence.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. The Department is required to approve or reject land development regulations that are adopted by any local government in an area of critical state concern. See, § 380.05(6), Fla. Stat.

6. “Land development regulations” include local zoning, subdivision, building, and other regulations controlling the development of land. See, § 380.031(8), Fla. Stat. The regulations adopted by the Ordinance are land development regulations.

7. The Ordinance is consistent with the County’s Comprehensive Plan as required by Section 163.3177(1), Florida Statutes, generally, and is specifically consistent with Goal 601, Objective 601.4, Policy 601.4.1, and Policy 1301.5.2.

8. All land development regulations enacted, amended, or rescinded within an area of critical state concern must be consistent with the principles for guiding development for that area. See, § 380.05(6), Fla. Stat.

9. The Principles for Guiding Development for the Florida Keys Area of Critical State Concern are set forth in section 380.0552(7), Florida Statutes.

10. The Ordinance is consistent with the Principles for Guiding Development as a whole, and is specifically consistent with the following Principles:

(a) Strengthening local government capabilities for managing land use and development so that local government is able to achieve these objectives without continuing the area of critical state concern designation.

(n) Protecting the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Florida Keys and maintaining the Florida Keys as a unique Florida resource.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Department finds that the Monroe County Ordinance No. 014-2026 is consistent with the Monroe County’s Comprehensive Plan and the Principles for Guiding Development for the Florida Keys Area of Critical State Concern and is hereby APPROVED.

This Final Order becomes final 21 days after publication in the Florida Administrative Register unless a petition is timely filed as described in the Notice of Administrative Rights below.
