Application for Special Inspector Certification

GENERAL INFORMATION

Section 553.79(5)(a), Florida Statutes, requires that a Special Inspector perform structural inspections on threshold buildings in accordance with a structural inspection plan describing specific inspection procedures and schedules such that the building can be adequately inspected for compliance with the permitted documents. Inspections shall include shoring and re-shoring during construction. Further Section 471.015(7) Florida Statutes states that special inspectors shall meet the requirements for qualification established by the Florida Board of Professional Engineers in Rule 61G15-35.003, Florida Administrative Code.

You are hereby advised that professional engineers shall not commit misconduct in the practice of their profession and that such misconduct includes, but is not limited to, performing work when not qualified by training or experience in the field or discipline of professional engineering involved. Further, engineers shall not make any statement or claims which misrepresent pertinent facts concerning their past employment or work with the intent and purpose of enhancing their qualifications.

In accordance with Rule 61G15-35.003, Florida Administrative Code, upon receiving the assignment as Special Inspector for a building, you must file a signed, dated, and sealed certificate with the enforcement authority stating that you are competent to provide inspection of that structure.

All required written reports shall be prepared by you and bear your seal, and shall be submitted to the enforcement agency in accordance with Section 553.79(5)(d), Florida Statutes.

Prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy, you are required to file a signed and sealed statement of compliance with the enforcement agency in accordance with Section 553.79(7)(a), Florida Statutes.

QUALIFICATIONS CRITERIA

The minimum qualifying criteria for Special Inspectors of Threshold Buildings, also referenced to as Threshold Inspectors, established by the Board shall be proof of current licensure in good standing as a licensed professional engineer the State of Florida whose principal practice is structural engineering or whose principal practice is in performing field inspections on Threshold Buildings.

Licensed professional engineers whose principal practice is structural engineering shall:

- 1. Demonstrate completion of three years of experience in performing structural field inspections on Threshold Buildings within the seven years preceding submission of application;
- Demonstrate completion of two years of experience in the structural design of complete threshold type buildings after having achieved licensure as a professional engineer; and
- 3. Submit three letters of recommendation from professional engineers whose principal practice is structural engineering in the State of Florida, one of whom must be certified special inspector.

Licensed professional engineers whose principal practice is structural field inspections shall:

- 1. Demonstrate five years of experience in performing structural field inspections on Threshold Buildings within the seven years preceding submission of the application;
- 2. Demonstrate certification in each of the following: advanced concrete inspection, advanced structural masonry inspection, advanced post tensioning, basic structural steel and basic soils from a nationally recognized entity such as American Concrete Institute (ACI), International Code Council (ICC), Florida Masonry Association, Post-Tensioning Institute (PTI), Florida DOT Construction Training Qualification Program (CTQP) or equivalent; and
- 3. Submit three letters of recommendation from professional engineers whose principal practice is structural engineering in the State of Florida, one of whom must be certified special inspector.

A Threshold Building is defined in Section 553.71(12), Florida Statutes, as

- 1. Any building greater than three stories or 50 feet in height **OR**
- 2. A building having an Assembly Occupancy as defined in the Florida Building Code which exceeds 5,000 square feet in area and an occupant content of greater than 500 persons.
