### What is quality child care?

Quality child care offers healthy social and educational experiences under qualified supervision in a safe, nurturing, and interactive environment.

## Indicators of a Quality Child Care Setting:



#### **Qualified Staff:**

Meets required training and certification standards.



#### Open Communication:

Provides regular updates and maintaining open feedback channels with parents.



#### Structured Routine:

Follows a consistent daily schedule with balanced activities.



#### Age-Appropriate Activities:

Offers activities that support learning and development.



#### Positive Guidance:

Uses redirection and encouragement to support positive behavior.



#### Parental Involvement:

Encourages parents to participate in facility activities.



#### Safe Environment:

Maintains a clean, well-kept, and child-friendly space.



#### Staff-to-Child Ratio:

Meets or exceeds minimum staff-to-child ratio requirements.

## **General Requirements:**

Every licensed child care facility must meet the minimum state child care licensing standards pursuant to s. 402.305, F.S., and ch. 65C-22, F.A.C., which include, but are not limited to, the following:

Posts valid license for parents to see.
Has Level 2 background screenings for all personnel.
Maintains appropriate transportation vehicles (if transportation is provided).
Provides written behavior guidance practices to parents.
Provides appropriate access to the facility during normal hours of operation.

Maintains minimum staff-to-child ratios:

- Creativity:
  Engages children
  in interactive and
  educational activities.
- Patience and Empathy:
  Responds to children's
  needs with patience,
  compassion, and stability.
- First Aid and CPR
  Training:
  Is prepared to handle
  emergencies
  with basic first aid and
  CPR knowledge.
