This permit may only be issued <u>for tegus</u> under the limited exception in Rule 68-5.007, F.A.C, for commercial users who possessed tegus or green iguanas prior to their listing as Prohibited species under a valid License to Possess Class III Wildlife for Exhibition or Public Sale (ESC) to continue commercially selling those species. To qualify for this limited exception, applicants must have had a valid ESC on June 30, 2020, and documented on their 2018 or 2019 ESC license application either tegus and/or green iguanas in their inventory or planned possession of tegus or green iguanas.

Authorization to sell green iguanas will only be issued under the limited exception in Rule 68-5.007, F.A.C. for entities that meet caging and biosecurity requirements in accordance with subsection (7) of that rule.
