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Requirements for Claiming Military Service

Under the provisions of Section 121.021(20) and Section 121.111, Florida Statutes (F.S.), members employed prior to January 1, 1987, may receive retirement credit for active military service in the United States or Allied Forces including certain periods of Merchant Marine service provided all the following criteria are met.

- 1. All or part of the military service was served on active duty during a wartime period as defined in Section 1.01(14), F.S., which includes World War II, from December 7, 1941 to December 31, 1946, the Korean Conflict from June 27, 1950 to January 31, 1955, the Vietnam Era from February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975, and Persian Gulf War from August 2, 1990 to January 2, 1992.
- Credit for such military service has not and will not be claimed under any other federal or state
 retirement or pension system where length of service is a factor in determining compensation
 received. Exception: Wartime service used for a benefit under Chapter 1223, Title 10, U. S.
 Code may also be claimed under the FRS if it meets all criteria.
- 3. The member was discharged from the military service under honorable conditions.
- 4. The member must be vested to claim this service.

If the FRS member meets the above requirements, and the member, or beneficiary is interested in claiming military service credit, the completed Form MF-1 with a copy of the member's discharge papers showing the date of entry into active duty and the date of discharge from active duty should be submitted to the Division. A form to request military papers from the Federal Government is available through a link on our website, http://frs.myflorida.com.

Upon receipt of the required documents, the account will be audited and the applicant will be advised of the amount owed to claim retirement credit for the service, if eligible. The cost of each year of military service claimed is 4% of the annual salary the member earned during the first year of creditable service under a state-administered retirement system in Florida after July 1, 1945, plus interest.
