CURRICULUM COMMITTEE MEMBER AGREEMENT FORM OEL-SR-7103

The Florida Department of Education, Office of Early Learning will select qualified members for the School Readiness Curriculum Approval Committee who represent the demographic and cultural diversity of the state to review and recommend curricula for School Readiness providers.

Please review the information that follows and consider the tasks and time involved. If you would like to be considered for an appointment, complete the application portion of this *Florida School Readiness Program: Curriculum Committee Member Agreement (Form OEL-SR 7103)* and return it to the appropriate address.

Composition of Committees and Term

Committee members are appointed by OEL and include, at a minimum, the following:

- Executive directors of early learning coalitions or their designee(s)
- Representatives of public school districts
- Representatives of institutes of higher education
- Representatives of OEL
- Subject matter experts

OEL may also identify alternate committee members to ensure a sufficient number of reviewers.

Qualifications

Each member of the committee must complete the OEL-approved Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards: Birth to Kindergarten training (2018).

In addition, committee members must:

- Hold a Bachelor's or higher degree in Early Childhood Education, Child Development, Elementary
 Education, Educational Leadership, or a related field, and must have held their current position for at
 least two years. Five years of relative employment experience may substitute for the above
 educational requirement.
- Not have any financial interest in any curriculum he or she reviews;
- Not have any personal interest in any curriculum he or she reviews (such as employment of the individual or his or her relatives, as defined by Section 112.3143, F.S., by the submitter in any capacity, or certification of the individual or his or her relatives as a trainer in the use or application of the curriculum within the past three years);
- Contact OEL to provide updated information when qualifications change or to request removal from consideration for selection when an individual no longer wishes to participate in the curriculum review process;

Committee Training

All committee members are required to participate in a curriculum review training. The training will include an overview of Florida's Early Learning and Developmental Standards; Birth to Kindergarten, and instruction on curriculum review to include navigation of the electronic

curriculum scoring system, Florida School Readiness Program: Curriculum Evaluation Scoring (Form OEL-SR-7106).

Evaluation Process

Committee members will receive information and support from OEL. The assigned curriculum package submission(s) will be shipped directly from the publisher to OEL.
